We've got ham hocks, chitlins and rock & roll at the Waldorf," declared a delighted Quincy Jones, as rock royalty gathered in New York to honor the first ten inductees into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. The evening brought out the nostalgic side of some of today's pop heavies. "I was born the year Fats Domino got discovered," recalled Billy Joel, who presented Fats with his award. "It's difficult for me to think," stammered Rolling Stones guitarist Keith Richards as he handed a statuette to Chuck Berry. "This is for the guy that started it all, as far as I'm concerned." Making the presentation posthumously to Elvis Presley were Sean and Julian Lennon. Julian recalled his father's words about the King: "Elvis was a saint. Whatever people say, he was it. . . I wanted to be Elvis." "We tried to get the sound that we heard and loved so much - the harmony of the Everly Brothers," said Neil Young of his days with Buffalo Springfield and Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young. "We never did get it." Other inductees included Ray Charles, Jerry Lee Lewis, Little Richard, James Brown, the late Buddy Holly and the late Sam Cooke. The evening concluded with an all-star jam. Berry, Young, Fogerty and Richards - ably augmented by Joel, Lewis and some of Paul Shaffer's *Late Night with David Letterman* band - swapped licks on "Roll Over Beethoven" and "Johnny B. Goode." Jerry Lee Lewis tore through his piano-pounding classics, and Steve Winwood belted out "Gimme Some Lovin'." And as audience members like Yoko Ono scrambled to get a better view, Fogerty played "Proud Mary" for the first time in a decade. As Little Richard would say:

"A WOP BOP ALU BOP A WOP BAM BOOM!"
