ALAN FREED'S "MOON DOG BALL" here 10 years ago resulted in a crushing mob of 25,000 Cleveland rhythm and blues fans rioting inside and outside the Arena. The Fire Department stopped the dance (dancing was really impossible) and charged Freed with overselling the Arena. Freed, then a Cleveland radio and television disc jockey, went to New York in 1954, where he was arrested for accepting payola for playing records. He later went to the West Coast and returned to disc-jockeying on a Baltimore station last week.
