

Freed started w/WABC on June 3, 1954

WABC had 1st refusal on Freed's appearance on TV

Stage shows

Labour Day, 1956 was 1st one - told F prior to this that to air on station he must pay - payed 10% of net profits for show - F also paid advertising costs prior stage shows too - got \$1000 from 1st show.

3 shows at Fox Tavern, one at Towns -

2nd show - Christmas, 1954 - 345 Announcements
WABC pay for 10% of net profits or \$4/m, whichever was greater, for show. - A sep. cost. w/Barronville Music - got \$4/m for this show

A 5 sub. - Jan 1957 - term cost. - had earlier patent I show coming up - ∴ wrote new w/Barronville patent cost. for 5 sub. per. - w/Barronville Music for Dire Music - \$10/m for 200 spots

2d cont. was req. on Mar. 26, 1959 -
 1/3 off Apr. 6, 1959 - 3 stops show per
 yr. At \$10M Adv. per show - A re-
 duction of this figure to \$7M per Labor
 Day show, 1959, as F show had brought
 in more inc. to WABC - he didn't have
 to put on 3 shows, but if he did he
 was req. to buy adv. - but in any
 event WABC could give him any time
 they wanted -
