I Talent K before Hoberman  
was with the station - Fred  
started in June 1958 - started  
as employee - \$800 per wk  
or a greater amount (scale)  
depending on the amount of  
time he was on the air -

could work on the outside  
if there was no conflict and  
the station used its first refusal

Talent day Fred show 1958  
somewhat before - Hoberman heard  
Fred permitting the show - Hoberman  
got in touch with Fred and told  
him that if he is going to advertise  
he had to pay.

As the time for the show  
approached Fred saw Hoberman  
and told him he wanted to  
advertise - agreed that a  
times sale K which amounted  
to 10% of the profits from the  
show (Barracuda)

10% of the profits plus  
out of pocket costs for line  
charges - to Station Theatre  
Station got \$1800 for the  
show -

Second show - Xmas. New  
Year 1958-59 - Fred wanted  
the same arrangement but  
agree. was 10% of the  
net profit or \$4000 which -  
ever was greater -

The period of advertising  
was expanded in these ads.  
Separate K with Bonacade  
\$4000 obtained by WABC

During Jan 1959 - talent  
K terminated was of Feb 1959 -  
Fred came to Wolman and  
told him about the Easter  
show for which he needed  
advertising -

Separate talent K drawn  
for a 5 wk period of a  
K was drawn for air advertising

~~was~~ with Boy Air Line for  
\$10,000 for 200 spot advertise-  
ments

This was merely an  
accommodation to Fred

The station already  
was advertising for a  
Fred replacement

III

Fred came back again  
and stated he was still  
going to have 3 shows  
per year and agreed to  
buy time in the amount of  
\$10,000 for each show

Labor Day show -  
K called for \$10,000 in  
advertising but the ~~station~~<sup>station</sup>  
acknowledged the new business  
the show brought so that  
the final billing was only \$7,000.

This was the K  
under which Fred was  
working when he was  
discharged —————
