

Patricia-Kahl Publishes

All Tunes From Freed
Film, "Rock, Rock, Rock"

NEW YORK—New York disk jockey Alan Freed (WINS) whose Snap- per Music Company publishes all the songs in the forthcoming rock and roll film "Rock, Rock, Rock", has sold all rights to the 22 tunes heard in the movie, to the Patricia-Kahl Music Publishing Companies for an undisclosed sum.

The Patricia-Kahl firms will immediately set the wheels rolling on a huge exploitation program designed to promote the more than 35 major label recordings of the 22 selections. The deal was consummated by Phil Kahl and Morris Levy.

Artists featured in the film include Frankie Lymon and his Teenagers, Lavern Baker, Chuck Berry, the Moonglows, the Flamingos, the Three Chuckles, Cirino and the Bowties, Alan Freed Rock and Roll Band, Jimmy Cavallo and his House Rockers, Johnny Burnette, the Coney Island Kids and Connie Francis.

Numbers performed in the movie include "You Can't Catch Me" by Chuck Berry; "Tra La La" by Lavern Baker (Mercury has recorded "Tra La La" with Georgia Gibbs); "Baby Baby" b/w "I'm Not A Juvenile Delinquent" by Frankie Lymon and the Teenagers; "Would I Be Crying" the Flamingos; "Over and Over Again" b/w "I Knew From The Start" by the Moonglows; "Rock 'N Roll Boogie" and "Right Now, Right Now" by Alan Freed and his Rock and Roll Band; "We're Gonna Rock Tonight", "The Things Your Heart Needs", "Thanks To You" and "Won't You Give Me A Chance" by the Three Chuckles; "Rock, Rock, Rock" and "The Big Beat" by Jimmy Cavallo; "I Never Had A Sweetheart" and "Little Blue Wren" by Connie Francis; "Lonesome Train" by Johnny Burnette; "Rock Pretty Baby" and "Ever Since I Can Remember" by Cirino and the Bowties.

The film will open in 165 theatres before the end of the year and will be premiered in New York, December 6th.

All of the record companies with recordings featured in the film, are also engaging in intensive promotions to get their versions off to a fast start.

A special "Not For Sale" LP of the recorded songs in the film has been sent out to more than 600 disk jockeys by DCA, the film producing company.
