

Well, the moment is finally here — the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum has opened its doors to the world.

After 10 years of planning and design, two years of construction, equal time given to assembling one of the great collections of rock memorabilia, and a monumental search for nearly \$92 million to fund its creation, the first museum devoted to the most popular and influential art form of modern times is finally open. We believe it was worth the wait.

This moment has come to pass because of the efforts of many. The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum was the brainchild of a handful of music industry leaders who came up with the idea and gave it form and direction. It found its way to Cleveland because civic and political leaders, along with thousands of funs, saw the potential that such a project held for civic rebirth and were willing to do whatever necessary to make it happen. It took its form and substance from the talents of architects, designers, filmmakers, and staff members who knew that a museum devoted to rock would have to be a very special place. And, it gained its credibility from the hundreds of artists who were willing to give of their time and most personal possessions to assure that the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum would truly reflect the legacy of their music.

The opening of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum is a time for celebration. It is marked by dedications, parties, parades, and most appropriately a concert of historic scope. Gathered fogether are dozens of artists who represent the history, the breadth, and the power of rock and roll throughout the decades. The founding fathers: Chuck Berry, Little Richard, Johnny Cash, James Brown, Jerry Lee Lewis: the great divas:

Aretha Franklin, Martha Reeves and the Vandellas, Annie Lennox; the performers who gave rock a new sound in the 60s, 70s and 80s: Booker T. and the MGs, John Fogerty, Robbie Robertson, Jon Bon Jovi, Richie Sambora, George Clinton, the Kinks, the Aliman Brothers Band, Al Green, the Pretenders; the new voices: Alice in Chains, Natalie Merchant, Soul Asylum, Snoop Doggy Dogg and Dr. Dre, Melissa Etheridge; and the music legends: John Mellencamp, (1) (the artist formerly known as Prince), and Bruce Springsteen—all are here to mix the sounds of the past and the present.

And after the celebration of this weekend ends and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum has been officially launched, what is most exciting is that a wonderful institution remains for generations to share and enjoy. The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum is a one-of-a kind museum — filled with exhibits, films and experiences that examine the roots of rock, that celebrate the history and accomplishment of the people who have made the music, and that explore the impact of rock and roll far beyond the charts. The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum will take you along on rock's journey from its tentative birth in the 50s to its worldwide ascendancy in the 90s and it will make you aware of what a remarkable journey it has been.
