We appreciate the services you have rendered and regret the necessity for this termination notice.

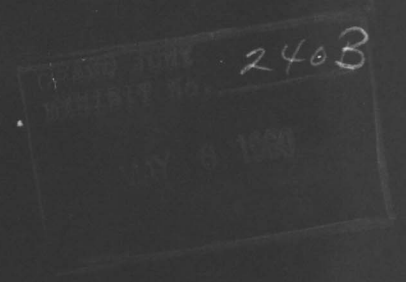
