This office is preparing for the trial of a defendant on the charge of commercial bribery.

Barthelmess is not a defendant, nor is he wanted in this country for any crime. This office merely wishes to ask him a few questions which only he can answer.

Reliable information supplied to us indicates that M. Barthelmess left this country in May or June 1959, and with his wife went to your city - Paris. We have reason to believe that he is still in Paris.

May we once again impose on the good graces of your office to check the files of aliens living in Paris to determine if M. Stewart Barthelmess was a resident, or is a resident, his present address, or forwarding address if he has left.
