Dear Mr. Davidowitz:

The preliminary investigation of our records indicate that the two engineers used on remotes by Alan Freed were Herbert Greenberg and Peter Lee. Of course during the period of time that Freed was employed at this station, there were undoubtedly more engineers involved. Many times this worked on a rotation basis. The station paid their salaries and in turn charged Alan Freed for the engineering expenses incurred as they did for line charges and producers.

As to the staff producers and the staff engineers who worked in the studio while the remote broadcasts were in progress, it is assumed that these varied with staff rotation and changes through the period of the years.

Alan Freed did a large portion of his broadcasts from his home. When this was done, he hired his own producer who worked with him at his residence and whom he paid directly.
